"It puts a federal legal obligation on the big tech platforms to take this garbage down, because they have historically been incredibly slow in responding to it. So now the victims have a legal right to say, 'Hey, that's me. I don't consent and take it down right now."

The Senate Foreign Relations Committee held a hearing last week to discuss the State Department's Fiscal Year 2026 Budget Request. I will keep working for Texas farmers and ranchers across the state to make sure they have the resources they need to keep their businesses, farms, and ranches open.
