Agenda Items: City of Willow Park becoming Home Rule including appointing a Charter Committee; Citizen Financial Oversight Committee; Employee to Calculate the No-New Revenue Tax Rate and Voter Approval Tax Rate; Budget Calendar for FY 2025-2026; Hub Int. to for Health/Dental/Vision/Life and Short Term Disability Benefits for city employees.



Community News Review: Town Hall Public Meeting, 29 May 2025, Willow Park Squaw Creek Road Reconstruction.

Summary: The project includes not only street reconstruction but also putting in a new waterline and addressing water drainage issues. The town hall consisted of a presentation done by Jacob Martin LLC engineer Derek Turner, followed by a public Q&A where attendees could ask general questions and then finished with residents speaking with the engineers one-on-one above a map layout of Squaw Creek Road where they could ask specific questions about what will be done near their properties.

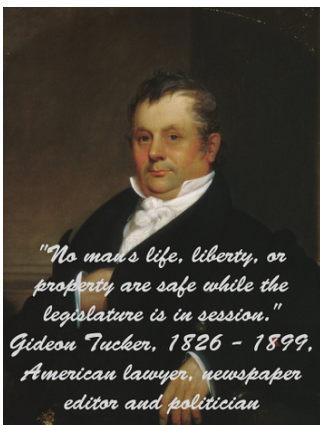
YMCA coming to Parker County, The Community News, 30 May 2025

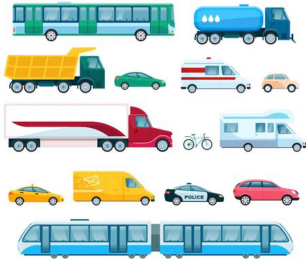
Senator Cruz News, Monday, 02 June 2025

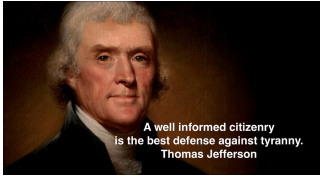
